Eligibility

The competition is open to all.

All skiers must hold a valid racing license issued by NC. If not, a Supporting Member Day License (SMDL) needs to be purchased during the online registration process.

All Québec skiers must also have a SFQ license or buy a SFQ Day License online for each race day.


Please note that no refund will be given for any daily license (NC or SFQ) purchased in error.


Racing up is allowed at registration online. but racers may race up by only one agecategory. The athlete who will race up must select the minimum year of birth of the new category when registering online.

Restrictions on Equipment

Only the Swenor 65-000 of the NC fleet and the Rundle Velox from Cross Country Ski Ontario wheeled skis with wheels # 2 will be allowed. Please indicate in the registration form the type of bindings you use. Skis will be assigned by random draw in accordance with CCR396.2.10. Poles shall comply with RCC 343.8.1 for free technique races. A safety helmet (e.g. DIN EN 1078 or equivalent) must be worn per CCR396.2.6 and protective glasses per CCR396.2.7.

In order to maximize the distribution of skis, participants are encouraged to have access to a pair of boots compatible with the other type of bindings. Participants should indicate on the entry form the type of bindings they are using.



Registration

Only online registration at zone4.ca will be accepted. No refund request will be considered. Registration will open on September 4, 2021. **Please note that there is a maximum of 175 registrants.**

The deadline for registration is Thursday, September 16, 2021 at 11:59 pm.


Registration costs per race will be \$25 for the U14 categories and \$35 for the others. Registration fees are to be paid online.

Confirmation lists will be posted on Zone 4 with the registration form. It is recommended that registrants check the lists to ensure there is no error, in which case you should contact the organizers no later than September 17, 2021 at 6 p.m.

Timing

Results will be posted in zone4.ca at the end of the race.

Seeding

A chevron start will be used, with athletes placed on the chevron according to CPL. Only double poling is permitted on the first 50 meters of the course in accordance with CCR396.8.1.2. <u>Distance CPL</u> ending 16 April 2021 will be used.

Skiers with a NC license and without points will have their starting order randomly drawn in the same group and will start behind the seeded group. Skiers of those categories without a NC license will have their starting order randomly drawn in the same group and will start behind the NC license holders' group.

The start list will be posted on zone4.ca on September 17, 2021, at 7 p.m. No changes will be possible after that time.

Bib distribution

Starting at 7:30 a.m.

Clubs with racers who do not return their bib at the end of each race will be charged \$30 CAD for their replacement.

Bibs will be collected in the finish corral.

Chips Distribution

Chips will be distributed in the starting area when skiers will be called for the start. They will be collected in the finish area at the end.

Clubs with racers who do not return their chip at the end of each race will be charged \$70 CAD for their replacement.



Skis Distribution

The skis will be distributed 15 minutes before the start to allow skiers time to become familiar with the skis and ensure proper function.

Skiers must use their own skis to warm up before going to the start area.

Skis will be retrieved in the finish corral. Clubs with racers who do not return their skis at the end of each race will be charged \$350 CAD for their replacement

Start Order

The start order will be published on September 17, 2021, at the latest.

Feeding

No food or beverages will be served on site or at the finish due to COVID-19. Accordingly, participants, volunteers and spectators are encouraged to plan to bring their own food and drink.



COVID-19



Please note that all participants from Quebec must present a proof of vaccination (printed, electronic or via the VaxiCode application) along with an identification document at bib pick up.

People from outside the province traveling to Quebec must present proof of identity with photo and proof, provided by their country or Canadian province, that they have received two doses of a vaccine recognized among the following:

- Pfizer
- Moderna
- AstraZeneca
- Covishield
- Jansen (requires only one dose)

Even with a vaccine proof, guidelines to ensure the safety of all individuals associated with the race will be put in place and will be observed. These guidelines, in conformity with Public Health guidelines (French only) for outside activities and events, will be communicated no later than September 17, 2021on the event page.

Please note that spectators are strongly encouraged to register on the online site in Zone 4 so that the organizing committee can reach them in the event of an outbreak during the event.
