COVID-19

Please note that all participants and <u>accompanying persons</u> from Quebec must present a proof of vaccination (printed, electronic or via the VaxiCode application) along with an identification document at bib pick up and access the site.

People from outside the province traveling to Quebec must present proof of identity with photo and proof, provided by their country or Canadian province, that they have received two doses of a vaccine recognized among the following:

- Pfizer
- Moderna
- AstraZeneca
- Covishield
- Jansen (requires only one dose)

In order to expedite verification, please ensure you have your printed, electronic or VaxiCode app proof of vaccination and identification on hand if applicable. Please note that participants 12 and under do not need to present proof of vaccination while athletes 13-16 are not required to present photo identification with proof of vaccination.

An athlete who does not present proof of vaccination will not be allowed to participate in the race and an accompanying person, on the site. There will be no exceptions.

Also, the mask is mandatory at the time of proof of vaccination verification.

Even with a vaccine proof, guidelines to ensure the safety of all individuals associated with the race will be put in place and will be observed. These guidelines, in conformity with <u>Public Health guidelines</u> (French only) for outside activities and events, will be communicated no later than 29 October, 2021 on the event page.

Please note that accompanying persons are strongly encouraged to register on the online site in

Zone 4 so that the organizing committee can reach them in the event of an outbreak during the event. Please note that accompanying persons are family members or friends of the participants.
